

Life Group Questions (Matthew 26:17-35

- 1. Read Matthew 26:17-35 together. If you're feeling up to it, read the parallel accounts in Mark 14:12-31 and Luke 22:7-23. What stands out to you from this passage? What questions come to mind?
- 2. Why is it important that Jesus is in control and knows everything that is going to happen to him? How do you see his divinity on display in this passage?
- 3. Verses 26-29 have incredible significance. What do you know of the Passover? Read Exodus 12:1-13 to get the context. What must have the disciples been thinking as Jesus assigned deeper meaning to the Passover rituals?
- 4. All of Jesus' disciples fell away and abandoned him. In what ways do we do this today? If you feel comfortable share stories of times when you denied/fell away/ abandoned Jesus.
- 5. In what ways do you see Jesus' grace and mercy in this passage? Is there something in your life you need to confess and repent of?
