- ➤ Reflects the love, kindness, and compassion of Jesus Christ our Savior and Counselor. Biblical Counselling is a caring process marked by Christ-like love, wisdom, and concern, which is intended to lead us to repentance (Romans 2:4, NIV).
- Uses the Bible as our main tool to diagnose, explain, and solve problems. As God's Word, the Bible provides thorough, authoritative, and sufficient guidance for every life situation, and is useful in showing us truth, exposing our rebellion, correcting our mistakes, and training us to live God's way (II Timothy 3:16, MSG)

For whom do we provide counselling?

Counselling is provided as a shepherding ministry to our NPMB members and attendees, as well as an outreach ministry to people in our community.

Who are our counsellors?

- Our counsellors are active NPMB members who have received training in biblical counselling, and have been approved by our church elder's board.
