

Life Group Questions Week 4:

"How could a loving God send people to hell?"

Take a few moments and share what stuck out to you the most from Sunday's message. What questions came to mind as you listened?

(watch teaching video at this point)

- 1. When was the first time hell was explained to you? Was it used to motivate you to follow Jesus?
- 2. From your own upbringing or culture, what are some different views of hell? Do some of our ideas of hell come from the Bible, or from popular culture?
- 3. Many people object to hell because they feel like they are a "good person". How would respond to that? Look up the following passages that talk about humanities condition because of sin:
- Psalm 14:3
- Psalm 143:2
- Jeremiah 17:9
- Romans 3:23
- Romans 8:8

- 4. Do good people go to heaven and bad people go to hell? (a common belief held by a lot of people). Why is it so important to understand the gospel when talking about heaven and hell?
- Read Romans 3:20-26 and Ephesians 2:1-10. Remind yourselves of the truth of the gospel. The free gift of salvation through Jesus. Good people don't go to heaven. Only people who love and trust in Jesus.
- 6. How do we grow in our affection for Jesus?

 Do you view your salvation as a "get out of hell free" card? How are you growing in your love and trust of Jesus?

Spend some time in prayer and worship. Thank God for sending his son Jesus so we don't have to fear his wrath. Praise God for your salvation! Spend time praying for those who don't know Jesus. Ask God to give you a passion for the lost!
