



Life Group Questions Week 5 - Gender (Part 2)

1. If you haven't already, watch Sunday's sermon and the Life Group teaching video. What stands out to you from the sermon and teaching? What questions come to mind? Did you disagree with anything?
2. Do you think most people struggle with their identity? Why or why not? Do you think most people try to find identity in their feelings or in what they do? Why or why not? Why might feelings or what we do be bad places to find our identity?
3. Read through Genesis 3:1-13. Take note of what the temptation for Adam and Eve was. How did the serpent twist God's words? What was the result of Adam and Eve choosing to sin?
4. Why is important as followers of Jesus to know our identity in him before doing things in obedience to him? How does being proceed doing? (think of the example of Abraham and the passage in Matthew 28:18-20)
5. Think through the 4 questions presented on Sunday. How can these questions help us when we sin? When we're tempted? When we have feelings that don't line up with Scripture?
 - Who is God?
 - What has he done?
 - Who am I?
 - What do I do?
6. If you feel comfortable walk through those questions in different scenarios of your life. (It could be a sin or temptation your dealing with. Or a feeling you are wanting to pursue)
