



Life Group Questions (Joel 3)

1. Read Joel 3 together. What stands out to you from this passage? Is there anything confusing in this passage?
2. Many passages in the Bible speak about God's final judgment on the nations. Look up the following passages. What similarities do you see between them? What differences do you see?
 - Ezekiel 38:19-23
 - Zechariah 14:12-15

Why does God use such graphic language to describe his judgments?

3. Do you find the topic of God's judgment hard? Do you know people who wrestle with the fact that one day God will judge every single human being? Why is that hard for us to wrap our minds around?
4. How is God's judgment a comfort to us? If you feel like being vulnerable, is there pain or suffering or injustice you are dealing with right now? How can God's future judgment of evil and injustice and suffering be a comfort to you?

Spend some time in prayer together. If you are dealing with pain or suffering or injustice bring that to Jesus. Ask God for comfort and trust in him. Thank him that he is not a distant God, but a God who will deal with evil and pain and injustice.
