



Life Group Questions (Amos 1-2)

1. Read Amos 1-2 together. What stands out to you from these 2 chapters? What questions come to mind? What is unclear or confusing?
2. One of the big themes for the book of Amos is God's universal justice and sovereignty. Do you struggle with God judging 8 nations in the first two chapters of Amos? Why or why not?
3. Amos 1-2 makes it clear that God is sovereign over all nations, including pagan ones. Read the following passages in Isaiah that talk about God's everlasting covenant with all human beings:
 - Isaiah 24:4-6
 - Isaiah 26:20-21
4. Why is it important to understand the bad news of the gospel before the good news? Growing up did you hear the bad news of sin and rebellion often? Why or why not?
5. Read the following passages about Jesus' role in fulfilling the law and freeing us from sin:
 - Matthew 5:17-18
 - Romans 10:4
 - Romans 3:21-26
 - Galatians 3:23-26
 - Colossians 2:14-16
6. If you feel comfortable sharing, what are some areas of your life that you need to surrender to Jesus?

Spend some time in prayer together. Pray for the gospel to sink deep into your hearts. Pray that as you realize your sinfulness, it would push you more to Jesus.
