



**Life Group Questions
(Week 2 - God's Pursuit in Our Rebellion)**

1. Read Genesis 3 together as a group. What stands out to you from this passage? What questions come to mind?
2. In the first 7 verses of chapter 3 we see where everything went wrong. What exactly did Satan tempt them with? In your own life, have you had experiences where you believed lies about God and it led to sin and rebellion?
3. Walk through some of the punishments for Adam and Eve in verses 16-19. Which ones stand out to you the most? Do these punishments seem harsh or excessive? Why or why not?
4. How was God gracious and kind in Genesis 3? (look specifically at verses 8-9, 14-15, and 21)
5. Do you think most Christians believed God's love for them is dependent on their performance? Why or why not?
6. Paul says in 2 Corinthians it is possible to live life without regret. What would that look like? Do you carry around shame and guilt for your past sin?

Spend some time in prayer together. Thank God for sending his son Jesus to be our redemption and righteousness. Ask God to remove the guilt and shame you might be carrying from sin that was already dealt with on the cross.
