They had an event planned for last Friday and were planning on taking some Christmas packets out to students prior to the online event. James was not feeling well on Friday morning so the packets were not sent out but they did have a good event with fifty or so participants. It turned out both James and Ann tested positive for Covid, so was a good thing the Lord prompted them not to send the packets out. They continue to do Bible studies via Zoom, which can even happen while they recover from their illness. They are showing a movie, *The Case for Christ*, next week. Pray that they would have good conversations around these events.

On Thursday, December 10th we found out that the whole household now has Covid, which includes S's parents. Please pray for healing.

Pray also for the students. They will feel very alone this Christmas season as the lockdowns have gotten tighter. Many will be confined to their apartments. Pray that James and Ann will be able to be an encouragement via Zoom and other media avenues. Pray that they will be able to find a way to get the packets out that have been prepared and are ready to go.
