Missionary Corner



The Baergs

Rob and Marlene are missionaries in a small, rural community in central Asia. Upon arriving 14 years ago, they realized many local farmers were finding the need to move to the city for employment, as farming on their land was no longer sustainable. With this in mind, their permaculture project was born in 2014 out of Rob's dream of planting a system of protected areas over the landscape that would create space for gardens and orchards as well as improved pasture land for livestock. The couple purchased a ten-hectare piece of land and began growing seedlings and planting fruit trees. Operating this project has allowed the Baerg's to teach the people in their community a long term environmentally and economically sustainable way of life connected to their land, their agriculture, their animals, and each other, all while sharing the Gospel.
