

Meanwhile, we were invited to Edmonton to participate in a video to document the beginning of the radio stations. We went on to see our sons and their families, some supporters and others we have ministered to in the past. We got pretty good at packing and

Thanks to the Lord and the encouragement of His word and your prayers, we actually got to Telegraph. After we passed our COVID test there, we were allowed freedom within the community. The house was in good condition, smelling fresh and with seemingly no damage from last winter's heavy snowfall. The people greeted us warmly; we did connect with many and distributed more radios. Clean up and repairs on the property kept us busy. Establishing the radio station and maintaining it has been challenging. First there was a forest fire, then COVID outbreaks, bad weather, road closures, and vehicle problems. Thankfully the Lord kept the gospel broadcasting 24/7. God is amazing and so faithful. Thanks for praying.

We had intended to stay about three weeks, but ran out of materials and the weather forecast was unfavorable. We left a few days early, praying that we could possibly return for several weeks in September-October, before the snow flies. At the moment there is another outbreak and the weather is wet, so it looks doubtful that door will open before snowfall.

We are grateful for the open doors we had this summer. Paul wrote to the Corinthians; "for a wide door for effective work has opened to me, and there are many adversaries." A number of years earlier Paul had tried to take the gospel to Asia but the Lord had prevented him. God had closed the door until Asia was ready to receive the gospel (see Acts 16:6,7) God's timing is perfect and He works, in what seems to us, long periods of time-yet, not to Him. Please pray for open doors and that we will be enabled to continue to maintain connections through phone, texting, email, and Facebook.
