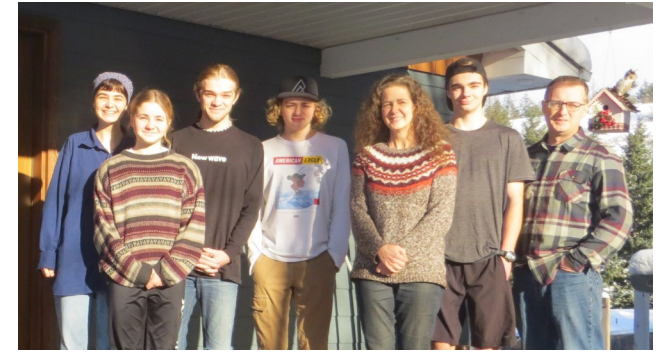
AGM Update: Our AGM was held on Monday May 9th. Don Banman was voted in as Associate Pastor of Community Life for a one year term, and both the NPMB and Creekside budgets were passed.

Kids Zone Classes: We wanted to take this opportunity to remind you how the classes work for Kids Zone. We follow the same guidelines as the public school system. Whatever grade your child is/would be in public school is the class they will attend for Kids Zone. This means that the birthday cut off is December 31st. When your child has a birthday, they will remain in the same class until the end of our Kids Zone year (June). They will then move into the next class in September.

Breakout: Our last Breakout of the year is on Friday May 27th at 6:00-8:30pm. Directions (we are going to be at the North Peace Cricket Foundation): Drive south on 269 road, approx. 1.5km from the highway, and go right at the big white gates. You will drop your children off here and pick them up here. PLEASE sign your child in when you arrive and out when you pick them up. Supper is included! The theme this month is "What a Glorious Day-The Life Yet to Come."

VBS Registration is open! Your children ages 3-grade 6 are invited to board the Rocky Railway, where Jesus' Power Pulls Us Through!! Seasons. God promised Noah that as long as the earth remains they would never cease (Gn. 8:22). There's a promise of variety in that -- "seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter" -- but sometimes it seems that seasons stretch longer than we think they should. God, help us to trust that You know best! We're in what seems like a loooooong season of accuracy checking with the Doku Bible -- and some days there doesn't seem to be any end in sight. Could you pray for Paul that God would help him to make quick, but good, decisions about how to translate? Sometimes the weight of a word choice seems heavy, and deciding between two (or more!) ways to say things, with their merits and drawbacks, can lead to a spiral of questions... Which is not ideal for moving the work forward! We have children entering different 'seasons' of life as well (our third child, Nathan, is graduating grade 12 this year); prayers for them are appreciated. As always, we can't say how much we value your prayers for this work, as well as your unfailing support. We're thankful that that season continues!
