

Please pray for Seegii, Tseegii and Iveel. Seegii (the husband) is our full time worker and his wife Tseegii does some occasional work for us as needed. They are also one of the couples in our marriage and family group. A week ago Tseegii started to feel sick and ended up going to the emergency room in extreme pain. She was feeling very poorly, was nauseous, and couldn't keep down any food. They've checked her for many things and haven't really found anything wrong. The doctor put her on antibiotics and she has now started to feel better. It has been very stressful and especially difficult for their 9.5 month old son, Iveel, who is still nursing. Please keep them in your prayers as she continues to recover.

Please pray for Rob. He has had a series of skin infections and is feeling pretty rough. We are not sure what is going on.

We had a wind and dust storm recently. The winds were up to 90km a hour. One of our workers, Enkhee, had her entire fence blown over and half of her roof blown off. Please pray for wisdom in how to move forward, as her house is not really worth salvaging. She likely needs to find another place to live temporarily until finances and time to build something new is found.

We recently hosted a lovely group. Tseegii was there. She is also working as a local school counselor. She came with an English teacher and three grade 12 students. One of these students was a good friend of the boy in our community who recently committed suicide. There is so much brokenness in the lives of these students. Please join us in praying for Tseegii as she has opportunities to speak with them.
