Suzanne and I are doing well. She was down with a relatively mild case of covid. The worst of it was over in just a few days and it took her about two weeks to fully recover. By God's grace I was not affected; I remained with a negative reading and was able to care for her. On May 15 we celebrated 49 years of marriage...hard to believe. We are blessed and thankful.

We have a very full summer coming up. I have trips to Mexico in June, July, August, September and October. I also have a teaching engagement in September and a family wedding in July. I am working through a rather complicated immigration appeal and trusting God for a favorable outcome.

I'm glad to report that the orthodox Jewish young woman who came to Christ last month is growing by leaps and bounds. Suzanne and I have stayed in touch with her. She is excited about reading her bible and attending church. This week she is planning to visit her family. Let's keep her in prayer. I am not sure what will happen if she tells her parents of her conversion. Many orthodox families will consider the convert dead and even hold a funeral for her. Please continue to pray for my mother who turned 101 at the end of April. She is still hanging on and refusing the Gospel.

Lately I have been reading scripture to her. She does not respond, but I know that it ministers to her spirit. Jesus who walked through a wall is certainly capable of walking into my mother's mind. And please pray that we will be able to come up to FSJ in the not too distant future. We miss our NPMB family and would love to spend some time with you. We want to be able to be with you in person: to express our appreciation and thankfulness for all the years of faithful prayer and support.

My prayer and encouragement for you comes from Romans 16:20 "The God of Peace will soon crush Satan underneath your feet..." May you witness the fulfillment of Paul's declaration. Amen
