They write, "SIM Canada and SIM Zambia have approved our request to spend a year in Canada for a variety of reasons. We have decided to spend the year in Fort McMurray, where we already have a place ready for us. It looks like Lucky has a job lined up in mechanics and is so excited to grow and learn more about mechanics in a different setting. I will be focusing on my masters in counselling which I started last fall and know it will be a great asset to ministry in Zambia. Niza will enjoy the summer before he enrolls in school in the fall. There are some big changes ahead for us all so we would appreciate your prayers through this transition. We know we need time to focus on us as a couple and us as a family and pray that we will come back with renewed vision."
