

Life Group Study Questions Luke 15:11-32

- 1. Read Luke 13:18-21 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
- 2. Have you ever had unmet expectations? Explain what it is. How did you handle the disappointment of not having your expectations met?
- 3. Why do you think all the religious leaders were disappointed in the coming of Jesus? Read Luke 17:20-21 to get an idea.
- 4. Pastor Andrew's first point was: The kingdom of God starts small and seemingly insignificant, but grows and becomes large. How do you see this in Jesus' ministry? In the early church?
- 5. Pastor Andrew's second point was: The kingdom of God exerts its influence from within, not from without. Why is it important to understand and believe this? How would it change your evangelism strategy?
- 6. What is the best way we can change Fort St. John for the better?
- 7. Pastor Andrew's third point was: The effects of the kingdom of God will be comprehensive. Read Psalm 72:19 and Habakkuk 2:14. Is it difficult living in the "already-but-not-yet" kingdom? How do we balance the already and the not yet?
- 8. Pastor Andrew's fourth point was: Although God's kingdom often works invisibly, its effects will be evident to all. What are some evidences of the kingdom of God working in your life? In the church? In a city?
