

Life Group Study Questions Luke 16:1-13

- 1. Read Luke 16:1-13 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
- 2. What are some good lessons you have learned from bad examples? (These can be scriptural examples or personal life examples)
- 3. The first point Pastor Andrew made was: "You cannot serve God and money". Do you think this is a problem in the West? In what ways do Christians attempt to syncretize these two?
- 4. Read 1 Timothy 6:6-10. Why is Paul giving such a stern warning about the love of money?
- 5. The second point Pastor Andrew made was: "Faithful in little, faithful in much; dishonest in little, dishonest in much". How does knowing that every dollar you have belongs to God, change your view of money?
- 6. In what ways can you grow in being a good steward of God's money?
- 7. The third point Pastor Andrew made was: "Use money to win people into the kingdom". What are practical ways you can do this?
- 8. Read Matthew 6:19-21 and 1 Timothy 6:17-19. How can you grow in generosity and sharing?
