



Life Group Study Questions
Matthew 22:1-14

1. Read Matthew 22:1-14 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
2. The first point Pastor Andrew made was "God patiently invites people into his kingdom." Where do you see that in this parable? Talk about examples of God's patience with his people in the Old Testament. Are there examples from your own life of God being patient with you?
3. The second point Pastor Andrew made was "God will judge people for their wickedness." Do you struggle with the idea of God's justice? Why or why not?
4. The third point Pastor Andrew made was "God's kingdom is both inclusive and exclusive." Think through the ways people in the parable rejected the invite. Do you view the man with no wedding garments as a rejection of the king?
5. React to the following statement: "You welcome to come the way you are, but not welcome to stay the way you are." Do you agree or disagree?
6. The fourth point Pastor Andrew made was "God is sovereign over the salvation of his people." Why is this a comforting truth from scripture? Does this negate our responsibility at all to evangelize?
