

Life Group Study Questions Acts 24:1-27

- 1. Read Acts 24:1-27 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
- 2. Have you ever read or watched a "character study"? (ie. The Great Gatsby, Citizen Kane) Talk about some of your favourite examples of this. Why can character studies be so helpful in teaching lessons?
- 3. The first character we see in our text is Tertullus. Read through his words and list some of his apparent character traits. Does Tertullus seem like a genuine honest person? Why or why not?
- 4. Why is flattery considered sinful in the bible? Look up the following verses that talk about flattery:

Proverbs 29:5
Proverbs 28:3
Romans 16:17-18
1 Thessalonians 2:1-8

- 5. What is the overall opinion of flattery is the scriptures? How do we as followers of Jesus avoid using flattery?
- 6. The second character we see in our text is Felix. Read through verses 22-27 and talk about some of his character traits you see in the text.
- 7. In the sermon, Pastor Andrew said cowardice is self-protection. Do you agree or disagree?
- 8. As followers of Jesus, why can we live without fear and cowardice? Read 2 Timothy 1:6-12 and talk through how to live with power, love and self-control.
- 9. The last character we see in our text is Paul. Read verses 10-21, 25 and talk about some of the character traits you see in Paul.
- 10. How can you grow in the area of speaking the truth with boldness and conviction? Do you have self-control and courage in stressful situations?
