

Life Group Study Questions Acts 25:1-12

- 1. Read Acts 25:1-12 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
- 2. The first point made was about God's providence (his rule and reign over all things). Why is good to be reminded of God's control over your life? Do you find this comforting or disturbing?
- 3. Read Isaiah 55:10-11. If God's purposes will always be accomplished, what should our response to trials and difficulties be?
- 4. The second point made was that even though God is in control, we still live with wisdom and integrity. How do see you Paul living like this in our study of Acts?
- 5. Read Proverbs 10:9 and 1 Peter 3:16. Do you feel like your life reflects these verses? Why or why not?
- 6. The third point made was about understanding your mission. Read Matthew 28:18-20 together. As you think about your own life, are you actively making disciples? In what ways?
- 7. As you think about your own life, what are ways you can pursue the mission of God?
