



Life Group Study Questions Revelation 4-5

1. Read Revelation 4-5 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
2. When you think of the word "worthy" what comes to mind? Are there specific people you think of who merit recognition as being notable and important?
3. Pastor Andrew's first point was "Humanity needs saving from outside itself". Read Romans 3:9-18 to hear humanity's condition as a result of the fall. What stands out to you in this description?
4. Why do you think human beings are constantly trying to save themselves?
5. Pastor Andrew's second point was "Jesus displayed perfect power and wisdom in weakness". Think about the Christmas story: what details seem to be weakness in our minds?
6. Pastor Andrew's third point was "Only Jesus is worthy to enact the Father's perfect plan of judgment and redemption". Have you ever interacted with someone who held a pluralistic worldview? (The idea that all paths lead to God) Is the exclusivity of Jesus offensive? Why or why not?
7. Pastor Andrew's fourth point was "Christmas is a remembrance of the worthiness of Jesus". This advent season, how can you intentionally reflect on this point? What are things you can do as a family to focus your Christmas on the coming of Christ?
