



Life Group Study Questions Ecclesiastes 5:1-7

1. Read Ecclesiastes 5:1-7 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
2. Talk about some of the church gatherings you have been to. What are some of the craziest experiences you've had in church services? Was there awe and reverence? Or not?
3. Charles Spurgeon said: "A time will come when instead of shepherds feeding the sheep, the church will have clowns entertaining the goats." What do you think of that statement?
4. Pastor Andrew's first point was we need to "Guard Our Steps". The Hebrew words used here mean watching, keeping or preserving our steps. What do you think this practically looks like? What are ways you can ensure your motives are good when you gather with the saints?
5. Pastor Andrew's second point was "Watch Your Mouth". Read Matthew 6:5-13 together. Why is it tempting to use many words when speaking or praying?
6. Pastor Andrew's third point was "Keep Your Vows". Have you had moments where in prayer you have promised God to do something? Did you follow through with it?
7. Why is it important to do what we say we will do? Read James 5:12. Are there things you have put off doing that you need to do?
8. Pastor Andrew's last point was "Stand in Awe". Have you considered that our church gatherings are primarily not about any of us but about Jesus? How can we keep the focus on him when we gather?
