1. Read Ecclesiastes 11 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind based on the passage? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
2. Have you ever felt "stuck" trying to make a decision? Did you feel paralyzed and uncertain how to move forward? Describe that situation.
3. Why do you think Christians sometimes struggle to make decisions? Is it because we want 100% guarantee it's the right choice? Or is there something deeper going on?
4. Read Deuteronomy 29:29. When it comes to God's will, there is his secret will and his revealed will. How would you explain the difference between those two?
5. Read Ephesians 5:1-17 and 1 Thessalonians 4:1-8 together. In these instances what is the will of God? How do we know?
6. Do you think part of the indecision we can experience is because of us wanting to know the hidden will of God? How do we combat that urge to know everything?
7. Why do you think Qohelet stresses the importance of learning these lessons while we are young? Is it harder for an older person to change their ways? How so?
8. In verse 9-10, Qohelet addresses young men. Do you see an anger and depression issue going on with young men in our culture? What are some causes of this that you can see?
9. How do we remove anger from our hearts and evil from our bodies? What would that practically look like?
