



## **Life Group Study Questions Romans 1:18-32**

1. Read Romans 1:18-32 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind based on the passage? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
2. How do you view 'God's wrath'? In your mind is it a primarily future thing? (Spend time talking about the culture's view of judgment? Is it biblical and realistic?)
3. In verse 19 Paul says that what can be known about God is plain to them. In what specific ways does creation reveal God's eternal power and divine nature?
4. Paul describes people 'suppressing the truth'. How do you see people in our modern culture actively pushing down or ignoring the reality of God?
5. Paul says that humanity exchanged the glory of God for images. What are some of the most common 'images' or modern idols we swap God for today?
6. Three times in this passage Paul says God 'gave them over'. What does this tell us about God's judgment? How is it judgment for God to give us what we want?
7. One of God's judgments is giving humanity over to sexual perversion. How do you see this playing out in our own culture?
8. Verse 28 mentions 'a debased mind'. How does a rejection of God affect a person's ability to discern right from wrong?
9. When you read this passage do you find yourself judging 'those people'? Read Romans 2:1. Why is it important to remember that we were no better off before Christ?
10. Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11. What hope do we see for people who are stuck in evil and wickedness?
